



6TH GRADE PARENTS – FAQ'S

❖ What will happen at the 6th Grade Open House?

Students will get their team assignment, locker assignment, and get a chance to tour the building. Also, PTSA will have preordered school kits available for pick up and school apparel for sale. You are welcome to put your student's school supplies in their locker.

❖ When do we find out about the bus route?

Bus route information will be available at the 6th Grade Open House. It will be posted on the windows right outside the main office. This information is also available on the Fischer website at the bottom of the page under IPSD Essentials (<http://fischer.ipsd.org/>).

❖ What if my child is struggling opening his locker during the open house?

Students are welcome to come back to Fischer during office hours and practice opening their locker

❖ What if my child has locker trouble during school?

During the first couple of weeks there are a lot of staff members working the hallways to help students with their lockers. If the teacher is unable to open a student's locker, the student will be sent to the main office to resolve locker issue.

❖ When will my child get his schedule?

Students will receive their schedules on the first day of school.

❖ Where will my student go on the first day of school?

There will be teachers outside the building greeting/directing 6th grade students to the wood gym. The students will pick up their schedule and wait to be escorted to class by their first period teacher.

❖ What if my child is going to be late for school?

If your child is going to be late for any reason, please contact the main office. Please note when you drop off your child, you must come into the building and sign your student in at the greeters desk.

❖ What if my child needs to leave early?

Please send a note with your child and have them drop it off in the main office. The office staff will issue a pass which will allow the student to be dismissed early from class. The student will wait in the main office until a parent comes in and signs out his child.

❖ What if my child is sick and will not be able to attend school?

Please call (630)375-3100 and press 3 to get the attendance line. This line is available 24 hours a day. You will need to leave a message telling us your students name, grade, your name, contact number, and the reason your student will not be attending school.

❖ What if my child left his lunch, homework, or instrument at home?

Parents are welcome to drop these items off at the greeter's desk. The greeter will ask you to complete a log. Please label the item with the student name and grade. These items will be place in a basket by grade and students are welcome to pick up these items between classes. If the item is not picked up before, lunch it will be brought to the lunchroom and the student will be called. Please note all instruments will be immediately delivered to either band/orchestra room for security reason only.
